The volunteer driver program is intended to provide individuals with accessible transportation; medical appointment, etc., that is suited to meet their specific needs. One-way, round-trip, and multi-stop rides are usually available; reservations are required. One-week advance notice is strongly encouraged for all ride request, and a minimum of 72 hours' notice is requested. All passengers MUST be able to self-transfer in/out of the vehicle with minimal to no assistance.

Transit is public transportation, providing daytime transportation services to locations within the city limits of the City of Northfield. Hiawathaland Transit has established routes that service the majority of the city limits. Riders may get on the route at their own discretion.

Hiawathaland Express bus is a public, shortened route (compared to the Blue and Red Hiawathaland routes). The Express bus is most commonly utilized to access shopping, dining, and the movie theater and runs Monday – Saturday, 4:00 PM – 11:00 PM and Sunday, 3:00 PM – 6:00 PM.

Dial-A-Ride

To schedule a ride, call the dispatch center at (866)-623-7505 between the hours of 6:00 AM and 6:15 PM Monday thru Friday or between 7:00 AM and 5:00 PM on Saturday.
